**Balance:** \$ 24,356.86 - \$ 27,174.41 = **- \$2,817.45\***

This balance is what still needs to be paid for the paving of the Church. We want to continue the work of the Church. Our next step is rebuilding the front of the church and the cost, according to the engineer's estimate, is \$43,733. I remark that the 2018 year was very eventful in our Parish in spite of the bad political and economic situation.

  - Reroofing of the Church
  - The paving of the Church's floor last December
  - Graduation of the 30 animators (catechists and chapel leaders) from Bible school
  - 72 young people made their first Communion
