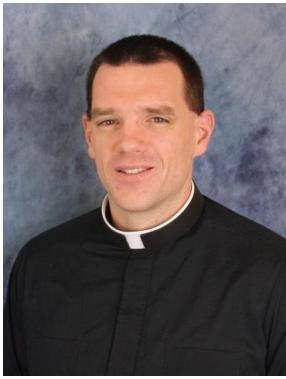
Please purchase the supplies and return them to the altar in a backpack with the child's name and grade clearly visible on the outside.
