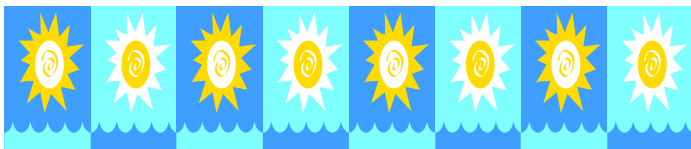
WANTED: VOLUNTEER EUCHARISTIC MINISTER:

HEARING LOOP: St. Lawrence Church has a special hearing system called "hearing loop." It connects the microphone directly to your hearing aid. You use the T-coil or telephone switch on your aid to connect to the system – most hearing aids have this setting.

It will give you a new hearing experience.

Just turn your t-coil on and you will be surprised at the sound you hear. If you do not have a "t-coil" switch on your hearing aid, check with your audiologist about it.

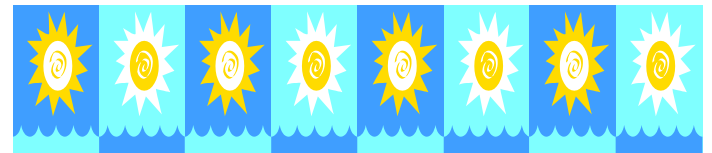

MISSION APPEAL WEEKEND: AUGUST 3RD & 4TH

Thank you for inviting our missionary priests to your parishes to make the appeals. We are from the Diocese of Guntur, State of Andhra Pradesh, India. Some of our missionary priests are already working in the diocese of Superior. The diocese of Guntur is a mission diocese. About 80% of the people in our diocese live in poverty and distress. Most of them are socially discriminated. They live in huts. They are all struggling to survive, earning less than three dollars per day. The children of these families are deprived of their basic needs. To help these children (below the age of 14 years) we are running 61 Orphanages. About 6,786 children are residing and studying in these orphanages. We are also providing to the poorest of the poor families of our diocese a drinking water facility through bore-wells, build toilets, etc. We have also organized the Catholic communities in the villages in the form of basic Christian Communities in order to strengthen the Christian faith and foster the Gospel values. Basic Christian Communities are formed in 120 villages in the diocese.

We have about 35-40 trained catechists working in different remote areas of our diocese. The Diocese has to build chapels and churches in a good number of villages of our diocese. Since we have got every year over two thousand adult Baptisms the problem of providing places of worship is ever growing. Since they have no churches in these villages the priests of these parishes gather the people in different houses to celebrate the Eucharist. As you know it is not any easy thing.

You can well understand that all these programs are costing us enormous amounts of money. We are now going through a very difficult period due to want of funds and we are really struggling to maintain our diocese. We need your generous love and support to continue the above mentioned projects and programs. The orphan children, poor women, people who do not have toilets and drinking water facility, Catholics who do not have chapels and churches in their villages are going to be the direct beneficiaries of your love and support. Fr. Joji Rayanna Pudota and I will be making the appeals for our diocese on all the weekend masses of August 3 and 4. Hence I request you to prayerfully consider our diocese and financially be generous in giving your support for our missionary cause. Please be generous in your support. Thank you!
