The person in this position will coordinate and extend pastoral care to parishioners who are shut-ins, in nursing homes / care facilities, or who have experienced illness, hospitalization, and or grief/bereavement. **Giving Tree --- Our Advent Ministry**

Below are giving options that will be on the tree in front of church during Advent. Decide which option(s) you will select to give to others.

- Visit someone in one of our local nursing homes or a shut-in in your neighborhood. Give them the gift of your time, pray with them and spread some Christmas cheer.
- Purchase a \$10 or larger gift card for gas. Place it in an envelope and return to the basket on the altar by Christmas. To be given to someone in need by our local priests.
- Get a \$20 or larger gift card for groceries at a local store. Put it in an envelope and return it to the basket on the altar by Christmas. To be given to someone in need by local priests.
- Offer a Mass or say prayers for those less fortunate than you or for someone who is suffering.
- Put together a care package for a nursing home resident that belongs to our parish. Deliver it yourself or return it to the altar by Christmas. Ideas include travel size toothpaste, mouthwash, or hand/body lotion, dental floss, a Christmas card, warm socks with gripper bottoms, soft candy or cookies.
- Get together a group to go Christmas caroling at a local nursing home. To arrange times, please call St. Anthony Nursing Home: Brooke Bierl, 794-5289, Regency Park: Rosa Stickrod, 792-9281, Accura Health Care: Shari Kratoska, 792-9284.
- Buy some groceries for our local food pantries and return them to the altar: items most needed right now include: jello, pudding, hamburger helper or chicken helper, canned chicken, tuna, pancake mix, syrup.
- Purchase baby items and return them to the altar by Christmas; to be delivered to St. Anthony Nursery for new mothers in need. Ideas include: baby soap, lotion and oil, small diapers, baby wipes, baby blankets, onesies, a rattle or teething toy.
- Purchase some warm mittens and a warm hat and return to the altar by Christmas. To be given to Kuemper teachers for students who come to school without any.
- Purchase a warm blanket and return it to the altar by Christmas. To be given to New Opportunities for a victim of domestic abuse who had to leave his/her home.
- Purchase essential items that some can't afford, and return them to the altar by Christmas. To be given to the Family Resource Center to be distributed to needy families. Ideas include: toilet paper, tissues, paper towels, laundry soap, dish soap, bath soap, deodorant, toothpaste and tooth brushes, shampoo, conditioner, cleaning products.
