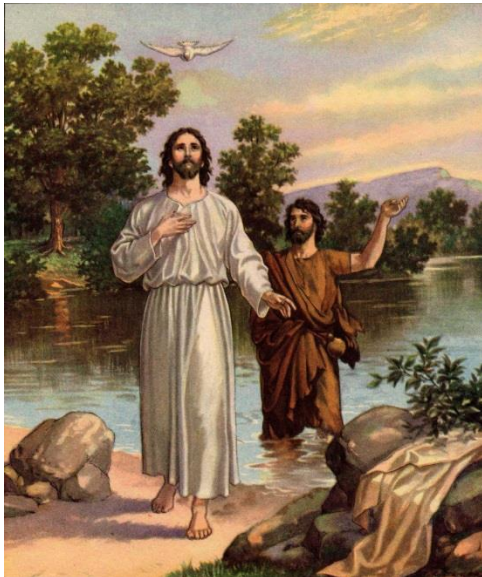

COMING SOON: After approximately 20 years of service to the parish, it is time for us to "freshen up" the Greteman Center. Work has begun to remove the wallpaper (which has begun to peel away in a number of places) and to paint the walls. Funding for this project is coming from an anonymous donor, and from other funds especially designated for projects at the Holy Spirit Church site. If you would like to contribute to this project, please put your payment in an envelope marked for the "Greteman Center Painting Project" and drop it in the collection or bring it by the parish office. Thanks for your help! We look forward to a fresh new look!

Thank you to all who participated in our Advent "Giving Tree" Ministry. Your generosity was greatly appreciated by the many recipients within the Carroll community. Our giving included: three large deliveries of household essentials to the Family Resource Center, three large cart-loads of baby goods to the Birthing Center at St. Anthony Hospital, two car loads of groceries to the Community of Concern, 25 blankets to Family Development Center at New Opportunities, two garbage bags full of gloves, mittens and hats to Kuemper elementary students, 40 care bags for nursing home residents distributed among the three nursing homes in Carroll, gas cards which totaled \$1,470, and food cards/cash which totaled \$2,410. Several of the non-profit agencies were overwhelmed by our donations, so this outreach became a special way for our parish to evangelize our Catholic Faith throughout our community.
