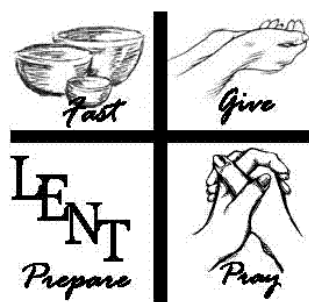
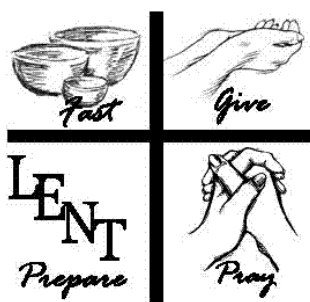
### IGNITE THE FIRE: TRADITIONAL LENTEN PRACTICES & THE HEALING OF RELATIONSHIPS

1. Go to confession (Can be within 8 days before or after the First Saturday)
2. Receive Holy Communion
3. Pray five decades of the Rosary
4. Keep Our Lady company for 15 minutes while meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary
