In loving memory of Wayne Mullan

My brother Wayne Andrew Mullan, age 55, passed away at his home in Brownwood on November 14, 2019. He was born on November 29, 1963, in Pretoria, South Africa, the son of Dr. Bertram and Franziska Mullan.

Wayne was always positive and never spoke unkindly of anyone. He loved his parents and siblings deeply, and affectionately talked about his nieces and nephews as if they were his own children. He had a gift of giving 100% of himself to each and every person he came in contact with. Wayne loved telling corny jokes that were very funny, and liked to tease his peers at work. Wayne was also an artist who found expression through his art. He created the logo “Stick Chick”, the mascot for New Hope Clubhouse which he helped to establish.

Wayne suffered from mental illness (Schizophrenia) most of his life, and by special grace achieved some degree of healing and recovery. He advocated for the rights and dignity of those battling mental illness and was an inspiration and champion for recovery. His faith in God was a big part of his own recovery. Wayne spread the message that “*You are not your disorder, you are a person and you must love and care for that person at all costs.*”

Wayne created mental health support groups in seven counties and through these groups he inspired hope that recovery from mental health issues was possible. He was highly regarded by these groups and by his fellow peer specialists throughout the state. Wayne worked to reduce stigma about mental illness.

It would be Wayne’s desire that his work, his legacy of compassion and love, continue. New Hope Clubhouse, a safe haven for adults whose mental illness has disrupted their life and need skills and confidence to reach their full potential, was close to Wayne’s heart. (www.centraltxclubhouse.com)

He is survived by his parents, Bertram and Franzi Mullan of San Antonio, three brothers, Gavin (& Hope) Mullan of Aledo, Texas, Fr. Glen Mullan of Sinton, and Bradley (& Sondra) Mullan of Allen, one sister Nicola (& Asa) Waterman of San Antonio, and fourteen nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his aunt, Inge Masur.

Funeral Mass was held November 16, 2019 at Saint Mary’s Catholic Church in Brownwood by Father Glen Mullan.

ADULT FORMATION CLASSES

Fr Mullan teaches an adult Scripture class based on the upcoming Sunday readings each **Wednesday at 7pm** in the Parish Hall. Everyone is invited, bring your Bible. These classes are required for adults preparing for sacraments (cf. below).

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend a Baptism Preparation Meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. Parents need to be registered parishioners and active in their Catholic faith. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the Baptism meeting*, held on an upcoming Sunday, at 2pm. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. The Baptism date, normally on a Sunday after 8:00am Mass, will be confirmed once all paperwork, fees, and requirements have been completed. Parents and Godparents can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in).

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend a Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the meeting with Fr Mullan*, held on an upcoming Sunday at 2pm. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
