Epiphany

The Meaning of the Gifts

Gold

Gold is the precious treasure of the earth. This child is a Glorious King. But his glory is not of this world. Only through his Resurrection and Ascension to heaven does Christ come into his glory. Scripture says that only pure gold will enter heaven—that which has been tried and tested in the fire and is able to withstand the infinite love of God. Christ is that pure gold. He alone is worthy to enter heaven, and with him enters his glorious Church, represented by Mary enthroned as Queen of Heaven and Earth.

Frankincense

Frankincense is a fragrant perfume representing prayer and sacrifice. The Christ Child is a Priest-King. Christ came into the world as mankind's high priest, to stand before the Father and offer sacrifice and prayer on our behalf. Christ intercedes with the Father for the sake of the Church, that she might be made holy and immaculate through the gift of himself, offered through bread and wine. The Frankincense represents the priest's prayer of supplication, thanksgiving, and sacrifice.

Myrrh

Myrrh is a precious oil used to prepare the body for burial. Christ was born to die, and his journey through this world was a funeral procession filled with sorrow. He came from heaven into this world to take upon himself the suffering of sin, and the pain of crucifixion. It began in Bethlehem under the threat of King Herod, and it ended at Calvary under the threat of Pontius Pilate. He wore a crown of thorns; he suffered, died, and was buried; and accompanying his body to the tomb with the burial ointment of Myrrh, were three holy women in mourning.

ADULT FORMATION CLASSES

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend a Baptism Preparation Meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. Parents need to be registered parishioners and active in their Catholic faith. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the Baptism meeting*, held on an upcoming Sunday, at 2pm. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. The Baptism date, normally on a Sunday after 8:00am Mass, will be confirmed once all paperwork, fees, and requirements have been completed. Parents and Godparents can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in).

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend a Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the meeting with Fr Mullan*, held on an upcoming Sunday at 2pm. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
