FEAST of the Baptism of the Lord

- By receiving John's Baptism, a symbol of repentance, Jesus shows that he identifies with sinners, even though he is not a sinner.
- By entering the water, Jesus makes the water holy, giving it the power of his own Spirit. Through his baptism, Jesus changes John's baptism into the Sacrament of Baptism which we now receive in the Church.
- The Sacrament of Baptism is not merely *symbolic*. The waters of baptism, through the power of Christ in them, *actually* wash away sin in the soul.
- The Sacrament of Baptism is the gateway to all the sacraments, especially to the Eucharist. In Baptism we receive the wedding garment, i.e. we are "clothed with Christ" and made worthy to enter the Church which is the banquet hall of the King.
- Baptism makes us "*Temples of the Holy Spirit*" (1 Cor 3:16, 6:19). Only the baptized may celebrate the liturgy and partake of the Eucharist.
- Through Baptism we are washed clean of Original Sin and all personal sins. We become Christ's holy bride, "*sanctified, cleansed by the washing of water with the word, that we may be presented to Christ in splendor, without spot or stain or any such thing, that we might be holy and without blemish*" (Eph 5:26-27).
- To celebrate the liturgy worthily and well, we must be in the state of grace, i.e., living in the grace of our baptismal consecration.
- Each time we enter the church we call to mind our Baptism by blessing ourselves with Holy Water. The water in the small fonts at each door comes from the church's main baptism font.
- Every year on Easter Sunday we solemnly renew our Baptism vows and are blessed with Holy Water. The Sprinkling Rite may be used in place of the Penitential Rite at the beginning of Mass.
- The funeral Mass also begins by calling to mind Baptism. The body in the casket is blessed with Holy Water, and clothed in the funeral pall which represents the baptismal robe.

Liturgical Ministers

Parishioners are needed to serve in various ministries during Mass. Ministers serve on alternate weekends, depending on the number of volunteers available. All must attend diocesan CMSE class and complete diocesan requirements. If you are interested in serving in one of the ministries below, please contact the office.

Sacristan – open and close church, set up for the Mass. Arrive 45 minutes before, leave 30 minutes after Mass. Period of training required. Must be active Catholic in good standing.

Reader – prepare and proclaim the Scripture readings. Must be active Catholic in good standing, with good articulation and speaking voice.

Choir – assist with supervision and singing in the choir loft during the Mass. Arrive 30 minutes early. Must attend Wednesday evening choir rehearsals.

Usher – assist with taking up collection, Mass count, and hospitality. Arrive 15 minutes before, leave 15 minutes after Mass.

ADULT FORMATION CLASSES

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend a Baptism Preparation Meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. Parents need to be registered parishioners and active in their Catholic faith. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the Baptism meeting*, held on an upcoming Sunday, at 2pm. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. The Baptism date, normally on a Sunday after 8:00am Mass, will be confirmed once all paperwork, fees, and requirements have been completed. Parents and Godparents can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in).

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend a Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the meeting with Fr Mullan*, held on an upcoming Sunday at 2pm. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
