## Parish Financial Information

### Annual Sunday Collections:

2017 Average: \$3289 Total: \$171,028

2018 Average: \$3955 Total: \$205,660

2019 Average: \$3614 Total: \$187,928

Sunday collections (and fees for weddings, funerals, etc.) go directly toward parish operating expenses. Annual operating budget: \$200,000.

### Parish Operating Expenses

The largest annual expense is the annual diocesan assessments & insurance (\$48,803). Providing for the priest (salary, health insurance, food, auto) is also around \$50,000. Utilities and regular plant maintenance is another \$50,000 (AEP = \$27k). Finally, office/administration costs \$30,000, and ministry/liturgical activity costs \$20,000.

The Bishop's Stewardship appeal (17,095) is *in addition* to the other expenses (cf. next column).

### Building Repairs

Building repair and renovation expenses are also *in addition* to regular operating costs. Our Sunday collections do not cover any of the Church A/C, Roof & wall repairs, upgrades and renovations. We depend on all parishioners to participate in fundraising activities to cover these costs, such as Fall Festival, King & Queen contest, selling raffle tickets, Sunday breakfasts, and bingos.

### Tithing

Catholics must provide material support for their local parish, the diocese, and other national and worldwide needs of the Church. The Bible teaches that the "first-fruits" of our income (traditionally 10%) needs to be set aside for the mission of the Church. The Church contribution must be a regular part of the household budget.

## 2020 Bishop's Stewardship Appeal

Thank you to all who responded so generously to the **2020 Bishop's Stewardship Appeal** this past weekend. Each year the success of the campaign depends on you. Once more this year, your pledges help assure the Diocese will be able to carry out its important ministries.

### ADULT FORMATION CLASSES

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend a Baptism Preparation Meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. Parents need to be registered parishioners and active in their Catholic faith. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the Baptism meeting*, held on an upcoming Sunday, at 2pm. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. The Baptism date, normally on a Sunday after 8:00am Mass, will be confirmed once all paperwork, fees, and requirements have been completed. Parents and Godparents can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in).

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend a Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the meeting with Fr Mullan*, held on an upcoming Sunday at 2pm. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
