“FROM PLAGUE, FAMINE, AND WAR DELIVER US, O LORD”

As we seek to protect ourselves from the spread of the Corona virus and other illnesses, our approach as Catholics is two-fold.

1) Spiritual

First, we look to God for grace and protection, healing and salvation. Plagues (epidemics), famine, war, and other calamities are part of our fallen world which Christ came to redeem. Regardless of what human remedies may be available to us, we always first of all pray to God for mercy and protection, and deliverance from all evils.

- Parishioners are encouraged to use holy water at home to bless themselves. In the prayer by which holy water is blessed, the priest always implores God for His protection “*against all illness and every snare of the enemy.*” Bottles are available in the candle shop.
- We will have the traditional “*Blessing of the Throats*” next Sunday after all weekend Masses, and use the Church’s traditional prayers for deliverance from plague, famine, and war.

2) Natural

Second, we always look to the natural means God gives us to take care of ourselves in this world, including the best scientific knowledge and medical practices. We must stay informed and follow the advice of civil authorities and medical specialists. This helps us to be prudent and practical, and not panic.

- For this virus (which is very contagious) and all types of flu and colds, do not be in public if you are sick.
- Anytime you sneeze or cough, cover your mouth thoroughly and avoid others around you
- Wash your hands often
- Minimize physical contact
- When at Church, minimize hand shaking and other physical contact, and respect those who do not want to shake hands (ex: Sign of Peace).
- Exercise extra care and reverence during Holy Communion, to minimize physical contact with the priest’s hands, since he has to distribute to many people.
- Avoid the option of receiving the Precious Blood by drinking from a common chalice.

Parish Stewardship – Thank you!

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend a Baptism Preparation Meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. Parents need to be registered parishioners and active in their Catholic faith. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the Baptism meeting*, held on an upcoming Sunday, at 2pm. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. The Baptism date, normally on a Sunday after 8:00am Mass, will be confirmed once all paperwork, fees, and requirements have been completed. Parents and Godparents can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in).

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend a Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the meeting with Fr Mullan*, held on an upcoming Sunday at 2pm. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
