Noisy Children

- Since we do not have a cry room available at this time, please help our parish by observing the following:
- Children have a right to be with their family in church. However, other parishioners also have a right to hear the readings, prayers, and sermon without distractions.
- If parents bring their small children, they should sit in the main church. For toddlers who are old enough to be curious and learn, they should sit closer to the front where they can see everything.
- If a small child begins to cry, make noise, or distract other parishioners, parents need to take the child to the back or outside until he quiets down. Don't wait too long, and don't be embarrassed—everyone supports parents who are helping their children to learn.

Posadas

“Posadas” (“inn”) is a traditional Advent Novena, by which the faithful journey for nine days with Joseph and Mary to Bethlehem, looking for a place to stay. The faithful visit houses in the neighborhoods, looking for hospitality, sharing the Christmas story, and inviting the people to join the Church as we prepare to celebrate God's Coming among us.

Each evening, we will meet in front of the Parish Hall at 6:45PM, and start walking at 7PM. Dress according to weather.

Our Lady of Guadalupe Procession

- The Guadalupe Procession will take place on Saturday, December 12, 2020, at 11am.
- We will gather in the church parking lot.
- Procession will begin at 11:00am with the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary, followed by instructions for the procession.
- We will proceed around a couple of blocks in the neighborhood behind the church.
- The image of Our Lady of Guadalupe will be carried on a bier by men from the Knights of Our Lady and ushers.
- Sodality will walk in front of the image, together with the festival King and Queen. Altar Servers will also provide escort.
- Choir will follow the image, and Guadalupanas, who will lead the Rosary.
- During the procession we will pray the Rosary and sing the “Laudate Dominum” response.
- Arriving at the church, Sodality will line the pathway, and strew rose petals, while the image is carried into the church to the side altar.
- Mass will begin at 12 noon
- Following the Mass, there will be a reception in the Hall hosted by the Guadalupanas.

ADULT FORMATION CLASSES

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend a Baptism Preparation Meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. Parents need to be registered parishioners and active in their Catholic faith. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the Baptism meeting*, held on an upcoming Sunday, at 2pm. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. The Baptism date, normally on a Sunday after 8:00am Mass, will be confirmed once all paperwork, fees, and requirements have been completed. Parents and Godparents can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in).

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend a Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the meeting with Fr Mullan*, held on an upcoming Sunday at 2pm. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
