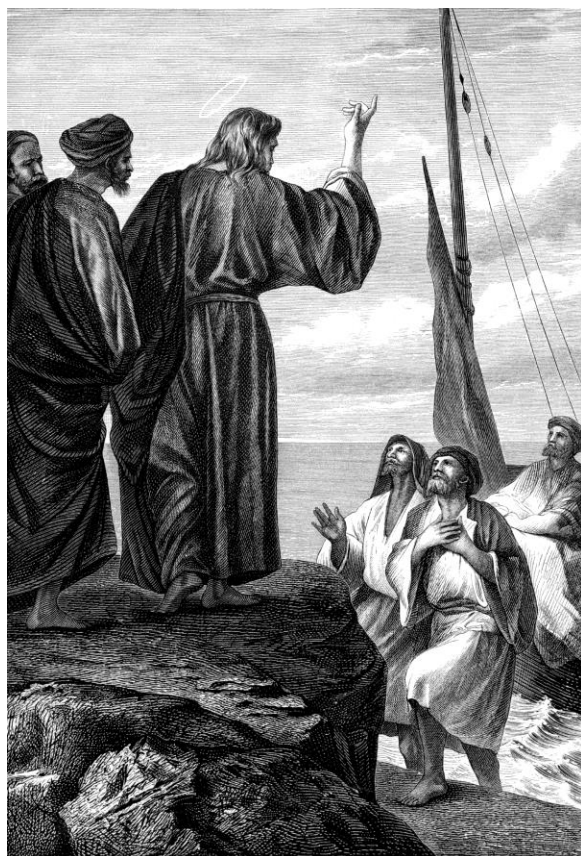

#### Feast of the Presentation – Blessing of Candles

The day of the Lord’s Nativity is known as “*Christmas*.” Forty days later, the day of the Lord’s Presentation in the Temple is known as “*Candlemas*.” The Light which was born into a dark world and manifested to the kings through a star, now fills the Temple as a “*light to the nations, and the glory of His people Israel*.”

On this day, it is the Church’s tradition to bless the candles used throughout the year during the Mass. Every time we celebrate Mass, we echo the Presentation, as the altar servers with the priest process into the sanctuary, carrying the candles which represent the presence of our Lord and the light of faith. The Feast of the Presentation will be celebrated at the 5PM Saturday Mass on January 30<sup>th</sup>. (This will still fulfill the Sunday obligation)

#### Blessing of Throats – Next Weekend

On the Memorial of St. Blase, the Church asks God’s healing and protection from illnesses of the throat (cold, flu, etc.), using the newly blessed candles from the Presentation the day before. Blessing of the throats will take place after all weekend Masses, January 29-30.

### ADULT FORMATION CLASSES

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend a Baptism Preparation Meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. Parents need to be registered parishioners and active in their Catholic faith. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the Baptism meeting*, held on an upcoming Sunday, at 2pm. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. The Baptism date, normally on a Sunday after 8:00am Mass, will be confirmed once all paperwork, fees, and requirements have been completed. Parents and Godparents can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in).

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend a Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the meeting with Fr Mullan*, held on an upcoming Sunday at 2pm. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
