## PASSIONTIDE

Whereas the first half of Lent focuses on the call to repentance and conversion from sin, the final weeks focus on the Cross and Passion of the Lord. It is called “Passiontide” and begins after we celebrate “Laetare Sunday” (4<sup>th</sup> Sunday) with the Rose vestments.

During Passiontide the bells are silent, holy images are veiled, and votive candles are not burned. The hymns meditate on the crucifixion, suffering, and death of the Lord, and the call to take up our cross and follow him.

### Sacred Cemetery

As we prepare for Palm Sunday and Holy Week, now is the time to gather any old devotional and blessed items, to be burned or buried. Each year during Holy Week, the Church has the custom of burning the unused Holy Oils, as well as burning or burying old altar linens, sacred objects, devotional items, and any other items that may have been blessed but are no longer used. These items should not be thrown in the regular trash, because they are sacred. We have on our church grounds a special area designated for this “sacred cemetery.” If you have any items to be disposed, please bring them to the sacristy or church office before Palm Sunday.

### Palm Sunday – March 28

Holy Week begins on Passion Sunday, when we remember Jesus’ triumphal entry into Jerusalem, welcomed as King and Messiah. Like the crowds in Jerusalem, we process with Jesus into the Temple, holding palm branches. Please arrive early for Mass next Sunday and *gather outside*, in front of the church under the trees. On this day, we will also hear the entire Gospel of the Passion, so plan for Mass to be longer than normal.

### ADULT FORMATION CLASSES

### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parents whose children need Baptism must attend a Baptism Preparation Meeting with Fr. Mullan at least 2 months in advance. Parents need to be registered parishioners and active in their Catholic faith. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the Baptism meeting*, held on an upcoming Sunday, at 2pm. Additional requirements (godparents, birth certificates, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. The Baptism date, normally on a Sunday after 8:00am Mass, will be confirmed once all paperwork, fees, and requirements have been completed. Parents and Godparents can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Baptism" when you sign in).

### SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Couples wishing to marry must attend a Marriage Preparation meeting with Fr Mullan at least 6 months in advance, to begin preparations for the Sacrament of Marriage. *Please contact the office to update your parish registration and schedule the meeting with Fr Mullan*, held on an upcoming Sunday at 2pm. Wedding date can be scheduled only after this meeting has taken place, and after it has been determined that no *prior marriage bond* exists. Additional requirements (sacramental certificates, retreats, Natural Family Planning, Affidavits of Free Status, bible classes) will be explained at the meeting. Couples can start attending the required adult Bible classes on Wednesdays at any time (please check the column marked "Marriage" when you sign in).
