FROM THE CANADIAN CONFERENCE OF CATHOLIC BISHOPS:

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) continues to post possible homily ideas and prayers of the faithful to help link the Sunday liturgy with the national pastoral initiative for life and family. The proposed texts for the month of June 2021 include suggestions from the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, 6 June, to the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time, 27 June 2021. As usual, the suggestions for homilies and prayers can be easily adapted for family prayer, as well as for personal prayer or for use with other groups or organizations.
