REQUEST FOR VOLUNTEERS:

We are looking for two volunteers for each Mass to act as coordinators who will ensure fulfillment and enforcement of the new guidelines before and after Mass. We are also required to

assemble a cleaning committee after each Mass to clean/sanitize the pews in the church, chairs in the hall and other common touch points with approved disinfectant spray. This will require 5-6 volunteers following each Mass who will be asked to wear their masks while cleaning and will be provided with disinfectant spray, gloves, and training.
