Lent/Advent: During Lent and Advent, the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Monday evening. See bulletin for times.

Saturdays: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is also available every Saturday from 4:30 - 5:00 pm or by appointment.

First Eucharist is received by second graders who have attended CCD regularly for two years. Parents are required to attend preparatory meetings.

Confirmation is celebrated in 8th grade for those who have attended CCD regularly.

Anointing of the Sick is administered as needed. Urgent calls will be answered at any time. Please call the rectory if anyone is home-bound or hospitalized.

Matrimony must be scheduled at least one year in advance. Please call the rectory and speak to Father Frank to confirm the wedding date and to begin the preparation process.

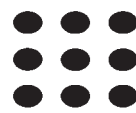
