Attending Mass at St. Emile Parish

Religious services or faith-based gathering allows for 50 percent of normal capacity or 150 people whichever is greater. **Face masks are to be worn at all times indoor public settings. Only exceptions are for those who cannot put a face mask on or take it off unaided, children under five, and those who are having immediate breathing difficulties.** At all times, a physical distance of two meters is recommended in indoor public spaces. Mass attendance will be on a first come first serve basis.

- Maximum capacity for Masses is determined by the ability to maintain social distancing between households and availability of live streaming in the chapel.
- When capacity is reached, a sign will be placed outside the doors and the doors will be locked.
- Please continue to do self-screening the day you plan to attend mass and stay at home when indicated.
- The province still requires that everyone attending Mass provide contact tracing information by signing in at all weekday and Sunday Masses.
- It is still necessary to maintain a distance of at least six feet or two meters from those who are not members of your own household. Weekday and the Saturday anticipated Sunday Masses will be live streamed for those who cannot attend in person. CHILDREN'S CATECHISM PROGRAM

We are starting our Children's Catechism program this October. Please pick up a registration form at the main entrance of the Church and submit it at the parish office. Sunday Catechism classes will begin on Sunday, October 3, 2021, at 10 a.m. First Reconciliation / First Holy Communion starts on October 13 at 7 p.m. and Confirmation in October (date is TBA). Those who are preparing to receive the Sacraments are required to enroll and attend the Sunday Catechism Classes, unless the child is enrolled at any Catholic School. There is a one-time registration fee of \$25.00 to cover the cost of materials.



Faith and Spiritual Growth

We have begun our journey of "Healing of the Family Tree". I continue to invite you to recognize a call to be a servant to your family, choosing to step forward for their sakes and seek God's healing touch in a perhaps, new way. What name(s) has the Holy Spirit whispered in your heart? What malady, no matter how dire, will you bring to the Lord? "Be not afraid. I am with you always. Come follow Me." To advance in the way of healing, we allow ourselves to seek what is dark and sometimes very painful in our family tree. The abscess, perhaps that has caused the scarring that we see today. Common roots of disfunction and disease (medical and emotional) are miscarriage and abortion. Often these are held secret and the lives of these infants have not been committed to the Lord and named. These situations are so filled with pain that there is an attitude of 'let's forget it all.' Place these on the history of your family tree and we will lift up each one at our Mass on Oct. 31st. Perhaps unforgiveness and anger, selfishness or abuse, are found in your search for healing. Pick them up as you would a hot ember, carefully placing them in God's care.
