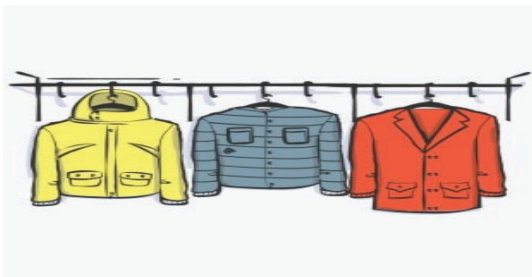
## Our Lady of Guadalupe
