Dear Students & Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to 6th Grade Math! I am looking forward to another amazing year of helping you navigate your way through the wonderful world of mathematics! This course aligns with the Common Core Standards for 6th Grade Math and we will be taking the New York State Exam in April. This course will require more effort than your previous 5th grade math class, and as a result, you are expected to complete ALL assignments that will be given throughout the year and put your best foot forward at all times.

Materials Needed:

- Binder with the following inside:
 - Dividers (will be set up together in class)
 - Loose-leaf (Graph paper may be used instead, but is not required)
 - Folder
 - Fabric pencil case (to be kept in binder) with pencils, extra erasers, handheld sharpener, dry erase markers, and highlighter (reinforcement labels are also suggested)
- An agenda book
- Pack of colored pencils or crayons (to be kept in locker)
- You are expected to bring your textbook, and binder with pencil case to every class.

Grading Policy:

- Grades each marking period will be based on tests, quizzes, homework, classwork, and participation and effort, and will be calculated using the following percentages:
 - Tests: 40%
 - Quizzes: 30%
 - Classwork/Effort: 20%
 - Homework: 10%
- There will be one quiz mid-way through the unit and one exam at the end of each unit
- Homework will be assigned every night and it is checked and graded on a daily basis. It is absolutely essential to complete the homework assignments, as they are meant to be practice for what was covered in the day's lesson and practicing the concepts at home reinforces what was taught. As per school policy, you have one week to make up a missing HW when you are absent. If you were not absent, you have one day to make it up and will receive half credit. This year all missing homework will be communicated weekly to parents on Fridays.
- Classwork/Effort is graded based on your effort during class, your participation in the lessons, your behavior in the classroom, your binder/notes, and your preparedness.
- Please note ALL quizzes and exams this year will be sent home, regardless of the grade received, to be signed and returned by a parent.

Extra Help:

- Extra Help is available on a weekly basis. There will be an "Open Door" extra help session every Friday during recess in Room 210. Extra Help will also always be available at the student's request.
- If you receive a grade lower than a 3 on a quiz or exam, you will be required to attend Extra Help. Parents/guardians will also be informed and sign a form acknowledging this.

Class Rules:

- Always be respectful! That means to your teacher AND your classmates.
- Come to class on time and prepared.
- All of the St. Edward's School rules apply in our classroom (uniform policy, cell phones, gum, etc.)
- All notes are expected to be copied and a neat binder to be maintained
- Complete all work on time

- Ask permission before getting out of seats
- Be responsible and accountable!
- Be HONEST!!!
- Above all....Always do your best!!!!

Class Procedures:

- When you come to class, immediately take your seat and begin to copy the notes on the board: the Topic, Focus Question and Opening Task must be copied and completed
- Copy down the HW assignment for the night and have the previous night's HW out on your desk ready to be checked
- If you finish these procedures, you have the option to read, copy the Daily Devotion, or review your notes. This is not socializing time.

Absences:

- If you are absent from class, it is your responsibility to get the notes from Google Classroom (they will be posted by 3pm each day). I will hold any missed work for you, but it is up to you to get the work and turn in any work that was due while you were out.
- If you are absent the day of a test or quiz, you will take it upon your return. If you are absent the day before a test, you are still expected to take the test when it is scheduled.

Communication:

- I will be using Remind 101 to communicate with everyone. All homework assignments are sent out daily at 3pm. I will also send reminders in regards to things such as upcoming quizzes/tests and extra help sessions. You can also use this app send me private messages. The instructions to sign up for Remind for our class are attached.
- I will also be using Google Classroom to post homework assignments, class announcements and to post all notes from the day's lesson. All class notes are posted daily by 3pm the latest.
