

Question	Answer
For children participating in remote learning, do they have to wear their uniforms while on the computer?	While uniforms are not required, they are encouraged during remote learning.
If my child does remote learning for the first trimester and later feels more comfortable and returns to in person school for the second semester will there still be a seat available for the child in their assigned class?	Yes, we are holding seats for those students who are remote learners.
The first 2 days of school are half days, will the middle school children remain only in the homeroom as in previous year? and if they do what do children who are learning remotely do on the first two days of school?	The expectations of remote learners are that they will follow what is being addressed in class. Remote learners will follow along with their homeroom.
For a child who is doing remote learning how do they participate in gym class?	With no wifi on the field, remote learners will complete an independent study for gym. Mrs. Townes will give assignments to the remote students and parents will attest to the student's physical activity completion.
For remote learning where do the children find the codes for google classroom, so they are ready to participate on the first day or will more detailed information be sent out on this?	Remote learners will be contacted prior to the first day of school so that they can be given their codes.
Will the school day be shortened (later arrival/earlier dismissal times?) I am learning that some public school districts are doing this to accommodate for teacher prep times.	No, the school day will not be shortened.
Will a virtual Kindergarten orientation be held through Zoom or Google in advance of their start date?	Kindergarten teachers are reaching out to you this week to provide further information.
Has the placement of air purification filters in classrooms been considered?	Not at this time.
If we as a family decide to choose remote learning what supplies would be required?	A family would require a device to log into Google Meet/Zoom for grades K-8 and Zoom for Nursery and Pre-K.

How is remote learning going to work?	Your child will log on for live classes. They will be learning in real-time as their classes are taking place. They will follow the schedule of their homeroom.
Does the student go in a Zoom meeting and get	Yes. Students will be required to attend a Google

<p>instructed at the same time as the students in the classroom</p>	<p>Meet/Zoom so that they are attending class along with their homeroom class. The teachers will have a microphone and classes will be live.</p>
<p>If after the first few weeks of school opening and we as parents are uncomfortable with the students being in the classroom would we be able to switch to remote learning.</p>	<p>Parents who chose in-person learning may switch to remote learning during the same semester; However, once chosen, they must remain remote until the change of the semester.</p>
<p>Why is there a deadline to sign up for remote learning before school starts?</p>	<p>Parents who chose remote learning must remain remote until the change of the semester. The deadline is in place so that students have their Google Classroom code for the first day of school.</p>
<p>The deadline to sign up for Remote Learning should be adjusted to 3 weeks after school starts.</p>	<p>Students need the code to begin classes with their homeroom so they do not fall behind. Keep in mind, if a parent chooses in-person learning they may switch to remote learning during the same semester; However, if a parent chooses remote learning, they must remain remote until the change of the semester.</p>
<p>Does every desk in every classroom have a plastic partition? How are they secured to the desk?</p>	<p>Every desk has a plexiglass partition which is secured with adhesive provided by the company.</p>
<p>Will the children be required to wear a mask and a face shield, or can they wear one in lieu of the other?</p>	<p>Children are required to wear face masks entering and exiting the building. They are required to wear a face mask when they move about the school. A face shield may be worn in addition to a mask, but not in place of a mask.</p>
<p>What are the staggered times for arrival and dismissal and how will that work for walkers?</p>	<p>Arrival and dismissal plans will be posted shortly. We will be opening the doors to drop off at 7:50 to allow for increased drop offs.</p>
<p>What does indoor recess look like? Will the children be required to sit at their desks or will they be able to play with other children?</p>	<p>Students will have to remain at their desks. There are games and activities children can play from their desks and without sharing game pieces. Classes can play charades, Would You Rather?, Simon Sez, Pictionary (with each child using their own supplies), hangman, etc.</p>
<p>What does outdoor recess look like? Will masks be required? Will the children be able to play together? Are they able to play with balls like usual?</p>	<p>When they are outside they will have to stay with their own class. They will not be able to play with other classes. No shared recess equipment. Other games can be played, such as Red light, green light, 1,2,3, Simon Sez, Mother May I, etc.</p>
