Dear Students and Parents of the Class of 2021,

In less than two short weeks, the members of the Class of 2021 will join the ranks of distinguished Holy Trinity alumni. We continue to plan for that occasion, keeping in mind the potential changes to Covid-related regulations that appear to be on the horizon. We will continue to communicate updates as they become available.

The Graduation Ceremony and Baccalaureate Mass will be held as one outdoor event on the Kutner Memorial Athletic Field at Holy Trinity beginning at 5:30 pm on Thursday, May 27th (Rain Date of May 28th).

It is necessary that all graduates [complete this form](#) by Monday, May 17th so that we may make appropriate arrangements.

Please take note of the following information regarding the graduation ceremony:

-Each graduate will be given four tickets. No additional tickets will be available, no tickets will be given out at the gate, and no one without a ticket will be permitted to attend.

-In-person seniors may pick up their tickets (and graduation announcements) during their lunch periods on May 19th, 20th, or 21st. Distribution will take place in the cafeteria.

-Remote seniors may pick up their tickets (and graduation announcements) at the Cherry Lane Visitor Entrance on May 19th, 20th, or 21st between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm.

-All guests will enter through the Newbridge Road Gate behind the bleachers. The gate will open at 4:30 pm. Families will be permitted to sit together in the bleachers with appropriate social distancing between households.

-Air horns, noise makers, signs and banners are not permitted and will be confiscated at the gate.

-Graduates must report to the school in their caps with tassel and gowns (which were distributed last August when senior portraits were taken) no later than 5:00 pm.

-The Mass and graduation ceremony will be live streamed on our YouTube channel.

-Following the ceremony, graduates will return to the school building to receive their diplomas.

Students are reminded that they are required to follow the regulations in the Holy Trinity Student Handbook regarding Personal Appearance while attending the Graduation ceremony. Other than honor cords or pins awarded to students by official school organizations (such as the National Honor Society), no items or decorations may be worn on caps and/or gowns. Flowers, corsages, or boutonnieres are not to be worn. In addition, gentlemen must wear a shirt and tie and dress pants under the graduation robe. Ladies may wear a dress or dress pants under the graduation robe. Graduates are reminded that they will be walking along the track and field during the ceremony. Footwear should be practical and appropriate for the occasion. Sneakers and flip flops are not permitted. If you have any questions regarding personal appearance, please contact Ms. Cooper.

Tuition payments must be satisfied as soon as possible. We cannot issue a diploma to any student who still has any outstanding financial obligation to the school. Tuition deficit payments must be made with certified checks or money orders. Please contact Mrs. Cetera in the tuition office for any financial matters. Graduating seniors must also return any outstanding library books and elevator keys. Senior student-athletes must return all uniforms to the Athletic Department.

I wish you all a very happy conclusion to your journey and education at Holy Trinity. I look forward to a Graduation that will give each of us a sense of pride in being a member of the Titan family.
