Dear Parents and Students of the Class of 2022,

On Thursday, June 3, 2021, Holy Trinity High School will be celebrating Junior Day, in recognition of the Class of 2022.

The school day will begin with a Junior Class Mass celebrated in the Theatre. During Mass, all Juniors will receive their Class of 2022 pin, and any Junior who purchased a school ring will receive it at this time as well. Following Mass there will be an awards ceremony for our Juniors where National Honor Society certificates, Junior Book Awards and several scholarships that are issued through our Office of Institutional Advancement will be presented. Remote students are welcomed to attend the Mass and award ceremony, but since it is taking place during the school day, no parents or outside guests will be permitted. The Mass and the awards ceremony will be livestreamed on our YouTube channel beginning at 8.00 A.M. Following the awards ceremony all Juniors will attend their classes as scheduled from 4th period through 9th period. Please note that all students must be in full uniform. There will be a modified bell schedule for Junior Day, and all students will be dismissed at 1:00 pm.

We are also happy to announce that the Junior Banquet is taking place on Thursday evening, June 3 from 6.00 P.M. – 10.00 P.M. at the Stewart Manor Country Club (51 Salisbury Ave., Garden City). Tickets will be sold in the Bookstore from Tuesday, May 18th through Monday, May 24th only. The price of the ticket is \$125.00; payment can be made in cash or by check/money order made out to HTHS.

Our Junior class faculty moderator, Ms. Suto, has met with the event manager at Stewart Manor to discuss the protocols that must be followed in order to be in compliance with Department of Health and New York State guidelines. While the guidelines are subject to revision, at this point, we can confirm the following regulations:

-The banquet will be limited to only Holy Trinity students in the Class of 2022 and designated faculty chaperones

-Tables will accommodate no more than 10 individuals

-Dancing will be permitted as per NYS guidelines

-As of May 19, there is no requirement for attendees to show evidence of a negative Covid test or proof of vaccination

If any protocol or requirement is updated or amended, we will communicate any change to you via email.

Any in-person student who is attending the Junior Banquet on Thursday evening must be present in the school building for classes on Thursday.

Friday, June 4, 2021 will be an asynchronous remote learning day for all Juniors. Members of the Class of 2022 do not have to report to school that day, however they should check Google Classroom for any assignments that are posted.

We are looking forward to celebrating the achievements of the Class of 2022. It promises to be a wonderful experience that will honor and commemorate these fine young men and women.
