Baptisms: Diocesan policy requires parents to attend a Baptismal preparation course. At least one Godparent must be Catholic ; at least 16 yrs. of age ; have received the sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation; and if married, be validly married in the Church and be able to receive Holy Communion, the other may be a Christian witness. Please contact the parish office for more details.

Adults for Confirmation: If you are an adult who made your First Communion but was never confirmed. A class for adults needing the Sacrament of Confirmation will be taught by Father DuPré . For more information contact the parish office.

Marriages: Contact Pastor (6) six months prior to the expected date to begin preparations.

Anointing of the Sick: A Family Member needs to call the office to arrange a visit from the Pastor to the Home or Hospital.

Funerals: The Funeral Director must contact the parish office on behalf of the family. Viewing / visitation of the dearly departed will no longer be allowed prior to a Funeral Mass or Memorial Mass in the Church or Chapel. The family will have to acquire the facility of the Funeral Home in charge of handling the arrangements.

Fete-Dieu du Teche 2020



The sixth annual Fete-Dieu du Teche Eucharistic Boat Procession will take place on Saturday, August 15, **Feast of the Assumption**. This year's unique 40-mile Eucharistic Procession by boat and foot will be offered in petition to God for an end of the **COVID-19 pandemic**. The boat procession will arrive with the Blessed Sacrament at 3:15pm followed by a recitation of the Rosary and Benediction under the Cecile Rousseau Poche Memorial Park Pavilion.

***The **bridge** in Parks will **open** for the boat procession to pass, so **please cross before 3:00pm**. Don't forget to invite family and friends to attend and remember to bring your **Rosary, a lawn chair and practice social distancing**.

***Residents living along the route of the Procession are invited to gather with family and friends to pray and show reverence by kneeling or bowing as the procession approaches near your home.

Plenary Indulgence

Pope Francis, through his Grand Penitentiary, His Eminence Cardinal Mauro Piacenza, has granted plenary indulgence to participants of Fete Dieu du Teche on August 15, 2020. The indulgence is granted to the faithful who devoutly participate in the opening Mass at St. Leo the Great in Leonville, to those making the procession by boat down the Teche, and to those who participate at the various stations along the bayou in the recitation of the Marian Rosary and Benediction. This is indeed a sacred privilege! This grant is under the normal conditions which means that the faithful must have the intention to gain the indulgence, perform one of the indulgenced acts as given above, be in the state of grace at the time of the event, have received the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Penance within 20 days, receive Holy Communion, pray for the Holy Father's intention, and be free from all attachment to sin, mortal and venial. The Fete-Dieu du Teche Plenary Indulgence can be offered for oneself or in suffrage for a deceased loved one.
