“Let the children come to me, and do not hinder them; for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven.” We are familiar with these words spoken by Jesus to his disciples. Our Lord observed the disciples scolding parents as they brought their children to meet Him. Jesus made clear that the young need to meet and to know Him. For centuries, this mandate has been the foundation for the Church’s support for faith formation, especially the establishment of Catholic schools.

As you know, the Church is deeply committed to supporting the proclamation of the Gospel through our parish schools, which provide young people with an excellent academic education grounded in our Catholic faith. By contributing to this year’s Catholic School Collection, your support can help alleviate the burdens our schools face, and God willing, ensure they grow ever stronger in their mission to teach the young the Truths of Jesus Christ.
