MORNING HOSPITALITY: Open Tuesday – Thursday, we provide basic needs and hospitality to our neighbors and visitors sufferings from homelessness, addictions, mental illness, and other issues.

EVENING HOSPITALITY: Every Friday night our parish invites community members to join us for a warm meal and fellowship in our Hospitality Center. The event is sponsored by a different partner parish or organization each week, with groups preparing the meal as well as helping serve and build community.
