# MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Doctrine of the Most Holy Trinity is the most important in our Christian Creed because it reveals the most important thing, namely, the nature of God and subsequently our hope for ourselves in God's grace. As the letter of St. John remarks, "GOD IS LOVE." (1 John 4:8) As the Trinity (God) is both present to us and still transcendent from us, we can be confident in one thing, "to know God is beyond all knowing." The Mind alone cannot contain all that God has revealed about Himself. After all, if you or I were able to accomplish that feat it would be like a water bottle trying to hold all the water from a flowing stream. A human brain, even the most profound intellect, is only able to contain a finite amount of the infinite love and knowledge of God. By reason alone we can know that a "God" exists. History and the evidence of Scriptures attests to a revelation of a God who is loving toward believers and yet beyond the believers themselves.
