CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY

Dear Friends in Christ,

On this Solemnity of Corpus Christi (The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ), I would like to remind us of an important prayer. It really is a prayer that should be memorized and recited in silence every time we receive Holy Communion sacramentally at Mass. We have learned that a "spiritual communion" is possible at every moment of our day and when we cannot attend Mass for serious reasons. This prayer, called the *Anima Christi* (Soul of Christ), can very easily be that prayer we use to spiritually unite ourselves to the love of Christ in the Eucharist. Pray it slowly, purposefully, and with great joy that God will not abandon us but gives us himself every day in the Eucharist. Congratulations to all of our First Communicants and their families!

*Soul of Christ, sanctify me.
Body of Christ, save me.
Blood of Christ, inebriate me.
Water from the side of Christ, wash me.
Passion of Christ, strengthen me.
O Good Jesus, hear me.
Within your wounds hide me.
Permit me not to be separated from you.
From the wicked foe, defend me.
At the hour of my death, call me
and bid me come to you
That with your saints I may praise you
For ever and ever. Amen.*
