# THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

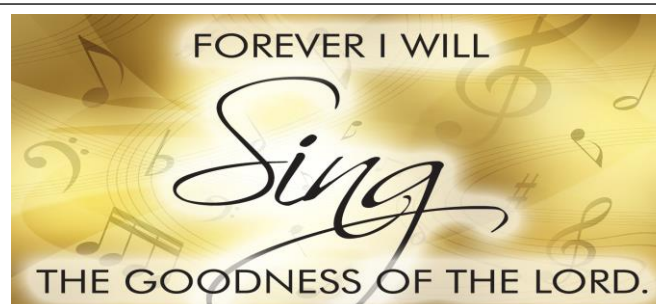
Dear Friends in Christ,
