Pentecost

Dear Friends in Christ,

We end the Easter Season with the Descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Church at Pentecost. I have a few updates to make you aware of for the month of June.

Due to the unavailability of a Priest to celebrate Mass, we will temporarily suspend certain weekday Masses only in June. Weekend Mass schedule remains the same. The full schedule of Masses will return to normal on June 28. Here is the plan:

- Mass will continue to be offered on Wednesday at 12Noon & Friday at 9:00am
- A Seminarian will lead a Liturgy of Word and Communion Service when Mass is not available (M, Tu, Th) at 9:00AM
- Saturday 9am Mass is put on hold temporarily.
- Wednesday evening Mass is put on hold temporarily.
- Holy Hours will be led by a Seminarian at the normal time and place during June.

Thanks for making this adjustment in scheduling. It is as simple as the unavailability of priests and our inability to compensate them for their time and travel.

Also, on June 2nd all mask mandates will be lifted. We will keep our areas in each Church for social distancing at this time. If someone should personally choose to wear a mask then we are all called to respect that choice and worship together safely.

The Obligation to attend/participate in SUNDAY Mass will return on June 5/6. For all those who have been attending a weekday Mass during the pandemic instead of a Sunday Mass, I ask you to consider going to Mass twice in a week. Finally, the live-streaming of 11:30am Mass will end on June 1/2. The Bishops appropriately remind us that watching Mass never substitutes for the real thing.

Thanks be to God for sending us the gift of the Holy Spirit. With every new change comes the choice to walk by faith.
