

## 2 Parent Meeting Year 2 | Confirmation | 2019-2020

### Explore Four

Explore 4 is a new way to receive attendance credit for Confirmation Classes. We have 4 categories for faith learning **and all confirmation students need 25 attendance credits**. There will no longer be Service Hour requirements.

Students must attend 16 (out of 18) confirmation classes, a minimum of 1 attendance in the Faith Practice category, a minimum of 1 attendance credit in the Service category, and a minimum of 1 attendance credit in the Social category. The additional 7 to 9 attendance credits (depending on how many classes you attend) will come from Faith Practice, Service or Social Explore Four attendance options. **The Explore Four Reflection Form must be filled out to receive attendance credit and must be turned in at the end of the month for the event attended.** The Explore Four Reflection Form may be placed in the drop box next to the "Explore Four" bulletin board in the Holy Family Center or in the drop box for the Faith Formation front office.

We encourage you to participate in Explore 4 activities as a family. This is how our faith is formed.

### Changes in the Calendar

There is a change in the calendar for parent and sponsor meetings. We needed to open an additional class and we no longer have parent and sponsor meetings the same evening as confirmation classes.

**There is no parent meeting in October** and the sponsor Meeting in March has been moved to February. February 26 for 2nd Year Confirmation students and Sponsors and/or Parent. The meeting is from 6:30pm to 7:45pm. A sponsor is required to attend with the student, or a parent may attend if the sponsor is not local or unable to attend.

### Changes in Class Times

There is a change in class times. Classes are 15 minutes shorter for both Sunday and Wednesday. **Class times for Sunday will be 3:15pm to 4:30pm. Wednesday Class times will be from 6:30pm to 7:45pm.** We needed to accommodate 5:00pm mass on Sunday and we changed Sundays class to 1 hour and 15 minutes. Class times were shortened on Wednesday as well to align lesson plans. This will help with the parent pick up on Sunday for our students and will keep the disruption to Mass at 5pm on Sunday to a minimum.

### Parking drop off and pick up

Parking drop off and pick up will both be at the stone circle side of the church. Students who are attending 5pm Mass on Sunday will need to have a parent meet them outside to walk them to Mass. You can enter to the upper level/sanctuary through the sidewalk by the large oak tree. A parent or adult must meet our students for their safety.

Please do not park on the east side of the Church or by the dumpsters. If you are parked in the "car line" area, you will need to wait to leave your parking spot until the car line has dismissed. Please see the attached file for parking. If your child is not picked up at dismissal, he or she will be brought into the

church office. You will need to park and come in to get your child. Should you have any questions, please do let me know.

### **Attendance Credit**

Students are required to sign in when they arrive to their classroom. This is how we mark them present. If they don't sign in, they will not be given attendance credit for class.

### **Classroom Expectations**

Please be on time. 3 tardies = 1 not present.

A Bible is provided to students. They need to bring their Bible to every class. This is the Catholic Youth Bible (Saint Mary's Press) and will be used for both Year 1 and Year 2. If it is lost and you need to purchase another, the cost is \$25.

Classrooms are technology free. No cell phone use is permitted. A \$25 donation to youth ministry will be required for youth who are using cell phones during Confirmation Classes.

Behavior Expectations: Our children are amazing, thoughtful, kind, and considerate. If there is a concern with student behavior, this will be addressed with the parent(s)/guardians. Concerns will be handled on a case by case basis.

### **Assignments**

The following assignments needed to be completed during Confirmation Year 1. If your child has not completed these requirements, his or her name is highlighted on the class roster. There are copies for you here. They are past due and we need them. You will not be able to select a Confirmation Mass if you have incomplete assignments/requirements.

Parent/Sponsor/Family/Friends Assignment

A letter of encouragement is requested for all 2<sup>nd</sup> year students. The letters are a secret. The letters are to be written for Confirmation Candidates for the Confirmation Retreat. These letters are given to students during the retreat and are very special and surprising to our kids. Please put this on your to do list. We will also be following up with you in the fall to receive these letters as the last Confirmation Class in the fall is on November 17 or 20 and we are on break until we see our confirmation kids is AT THE RETREAT.

A paper copy will be sent home during the month of the assignment and an email reminder. Should you lose that copy, the file will be placed on the youth ministry website for you to print additional copies.

### **Other Events**

Spirit Day is Saturday, September 28<sup>th</sup> from 1:30 to 6:00pm and is required for all 2<sup>nd</sup> year students.

Confirmation Retreat is January 17, 18, and 19. We arrive Friday evening and depart early afternoon on Sunday. The retreat is required for all 2<sup>nd</sup> year students.

Reconciliation (Parish Penance Service) on March 2 in the evening. Reconciliation is required at a minimum of once a year during Lent according to the teachings of the Church. If you are unable to go to the parish penance service, Reconciliation is offered on Tuesdays and Saturdays at Our Lady of the Lake.

### **Confirmation Mass and Rehearsal**

Confirmation Masses are scheduled for May 7 OR May 8. Selection for a confirmation mass will be sent home in February and if your child's assignments are complete, you may choose a mass day.

Rehearsal is on Wednesday, May 6 for both Masses at 2 different times. Thursday Mass rehearsal is 1<sup>st</sup> followed by Friday Mass Rehearsal. You will receive communication confirming your mass selection of your Mass Day and Rehearsal Time.

A sponsor is required for a confirmation candidate. If your sponsor is unable to attend Confirmation Rehearsal or Mass, then we would need to have someone stand in for the sponsor. The sponsor will be listed on the Certificate of Confirmation even if someone else stands in as a sponsor for your child's Confirmation Mass.

### **Communications**

Youth Ministry uses **Flocknotes** to communicate with families. If there is a weather cancellation, this is how we let you know. If there is an important parent reminder, this is how we communicate with families. You do not need to create an additional account with Flocknotes, but you will need to join my groups.

- WEDNESDAY WE NEED: Classroom helpers to help prepare the classroom.
- SUNDAY WE NEED: Safety Monitors to help with drop off and pick up, patrol classroom areas, HFC, parking lot, and grounds during your child's lesson.

Volunteer commitments include being here/80% attendance and committing to 10 hours of learning for yourself as an adult through classes here at the church, in addition to attending volunteer meetings. If you complete these requirements, youth ministry provides a "Pay it Forward" where your child's next year class fee for youth group will be waived.
