Also, continue to have your child count to 100 by ones, twos, fives, and tens, count on to 100 by ones from any number 1-99, and find the number that is one more and one less from any number 1-30.

$2+3=5$

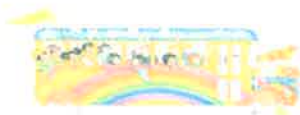
$4-1=3$

We will finish our last Superkids Book this month. It's amazing to see the growth the children have made. They have become good readers, spellers, and writers. During the summer, continue to have your child practice his/her reading skills. Your child can do this by reading the high frequency words and rereading the stories in the Superkids books.

Rereading the stories will help build their fluency and better prepare them to become independent readers in 1st grade. It is important to keep students reading throughout the summer. Also, Superkids Online Fun is available during the summer. There are stories that your child can read that we have not read in class. When you read to your child ask them questions such as: Who are the characters? What happened in the story? Where did the story take place (setting)? When does the story take place? Why did it happen?
