

Elk are excellent swimmers and can run very fast.

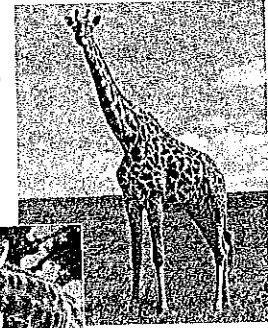

Unlike dogs, foxes like to hunt alone.

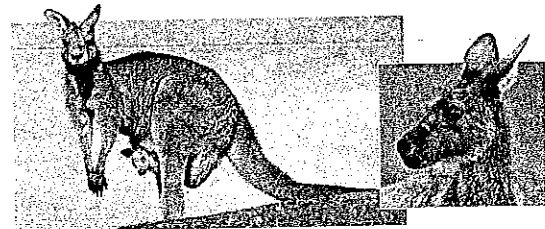

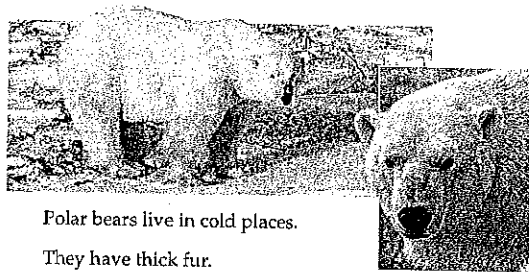


The great gray kangaroo carries its babies in its pouch.

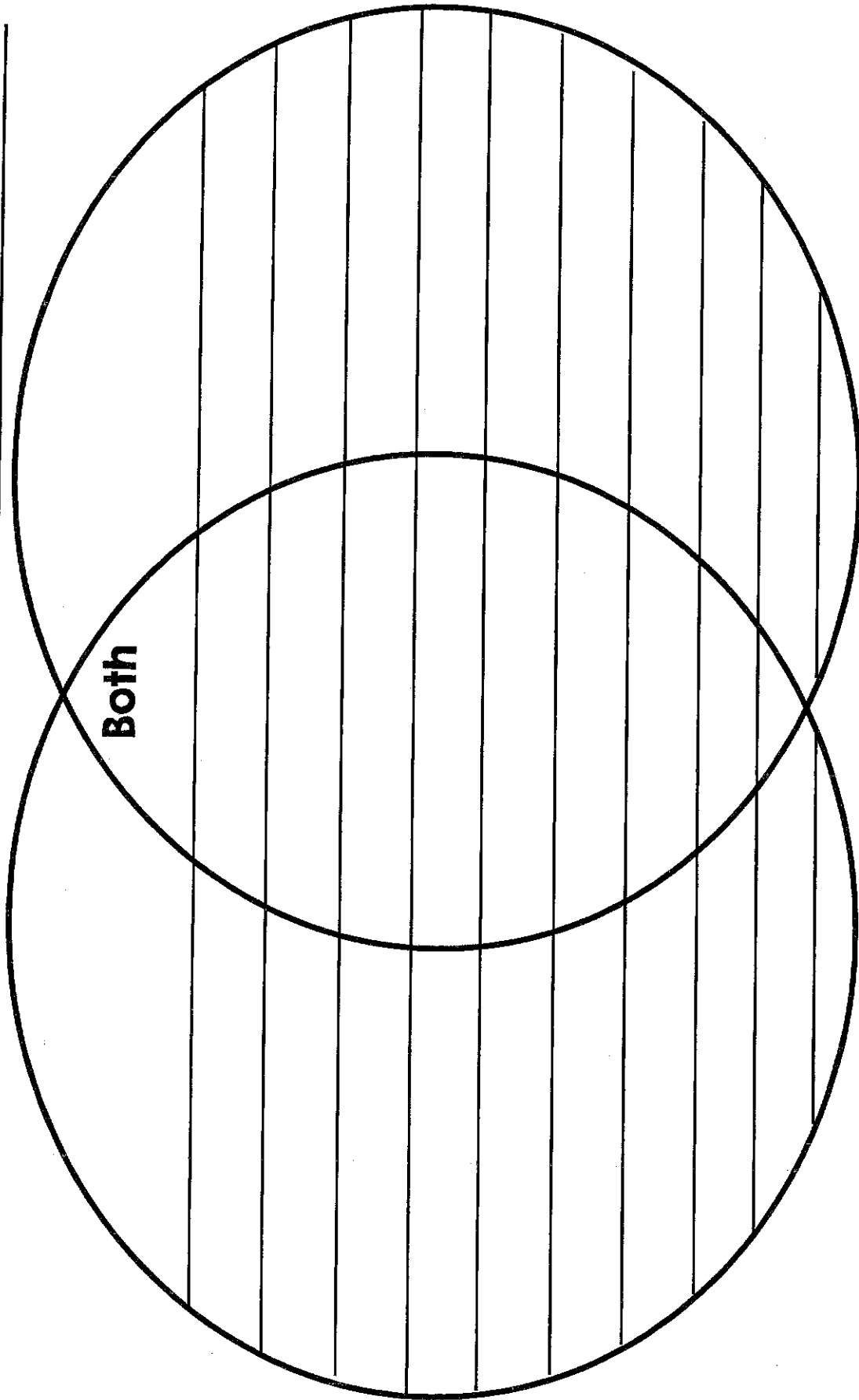

4. The Presentation in the Temple
5. The Finding in the Temple

The Five Sorrowful Mysteries are traditionally prayed  
on Tuesdays, Fridays:

1. The Agony in the Garden
2. The Scourging at the Pillar
3. The Crowning with Thorns
4. The Carrying of the Cross
5. The Crucifixion and Death

The Five Glorious Mysteries are traditionally prayed on  
Wednesdays and on Sundays:

1. The Resurrection
2. The Ascension
3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit
4. The Assumption
5. The Coronation of Mary

The Five Luminous Mysteries are traditionally prayed  
on Thursdays:

1. The Baptism of Christ in the Jordan
2. The Wedding Feast at Cana
3. Jesus' Proclamation of the Coming of the Kingdom of God
4. The Transfiguration
5. The Institution of the Eucharist

### Chaplet of Divine Mercy

Our Father, Hail Mary and the Apostle's Creed  
For each of the five decades (*On each "Our Father"  
bead of the rosary, pray*)

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul  
and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord,  
Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the  
whole world.

(*On each of the 10 "Hail Mary" beads, pray*)

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on  
us and on the whole world.

Concluding prayer (*Repeat 3 times*)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One,  
have mercy on us and on the whole world.

### St. Michael Prayer

St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our  
defense against the wickedness and snares of the Devil.  
May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O  
Prince of the heavenly hosts, by the power of God,  
thrust into hell Satan, and all the evil spirits, who prowl  
about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen.

### Memorare

Remember, O Most Gracious Virgin Mary, that never  
was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection,  
implored thy help, or sought thy intercession was left  
unaided. Inspired by this confidence I fly unto thee, O  
Virgin of Virgins my Mother. Do thee do I come,  
before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of  
the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy  
mercy, hear and answer me. Amen.

### Angel of God Prayer
