

Covid-19 guidelines for
weddings/15eras updated 3/31/2021

IN CHURCH

- There is a maximum capacity of 70 people allowed in church. This includes musicians and photographers.
- Only the front 2 pews will be reserved for 8 individual household with a maximum of 4 individuals per household.
- The entrance procession will only include the couple and/or parents
- All others will be seated as they enter. They will be given the next available pew and must stay in that pew.
- People are not allowed to leave and come back into church.
- Bathrooms are available outside before/after ceremony.
- Padrinos will not present their gifts to couple during the ceremony. These gifts will be placed on a table near the groom and the groom will retrieve them during the ceremony.
- EVERYONE MUST WEAR A MASK FOR THE ENTIRE CEREMONY
- The bride and groom can remove their mask during the vows, rings, coins and lazo.
- Communion will be given to bride and groom at normal time.
- Other's will receive communion as they leave the church.
- Everyone will be dismissed pew by pew
- The couple and their parents only will remain behind for photos by altar.
- Everyone & all decorations must be out of church 1 hour after the scheduled start time of the ceremony.
- Church will be opened 25 minutes prior to the scheduled event start time.
- People not complying with regulations may be denied entry and/or asked to leave.
- REHERSALS will be done by phone only.
- Family members can still proclaim readings
- Everyone must enter through ramp side door.
- While covid-19 cleaning procedures are required post-event, there is an extra \$75.00 charge that must be paid beforehand to the parish office.

Outside

- There is a maximum capacity of 200 people. This includes musicians and photographers.
- No chairs are provided, they must be rented from an outside vender
- People must maintain the appropriate social distance between households
- The entrance procession will only include the couple and/or parents
- People are not allowed to leave and come back into church.
- Bathrooms are available during the ceremony.

- Padrinos will not present their gifts to couple during the ceremony. These gifts will be placed on a table near the groom and the groom will retrieve them during the ceremony.
- EVERYONE MUST WEAR A MASK FOR THE ENTIRE CEREMONY
- The bride and groom can remove their mask during the vows, rings, coins and lazo.
- Communion will be given to everyone at normal time and directions will be given to maintain social distancing.
- Everyone & all decorations/chairs must be off the lawn 1 hour after the scheduled start time of the ceremony.
- People not complying with regulations may be asked to leave.
- REHERSALS will be done by phone only.
- Family members can still proclaim readings
- If there is no event immediately prior to your event, you can choose the ramp side or middle lawn side. Otherwise you will be given the next available lawn.
