Bruce Smith

During this season of struggle in the Church, we should pray for many holy men and women to be raised up in our midst. Our history at St. Lawrence includes a person who was a model of this holiness. It was lived out in ordinary life, but in an extraordinary way.

Bruce Smith was a student at the University of Minnesota and came to Mass here at St. Lawrence while he was a student. He played football for the Golden Gophers, and he won the Heisman Trophy in 1941 as the best college football player in the country. He led the team in two consecutive undefeated seasons, and they won the National Championship both years.

Faith was an important part of Bruce Smith's life. He gave the Lord an hour a day, and spent those hours either in prayer here at St. Lawrence or in charitable work.

It is great to have such an example of faith in Bruce Smith during his time here at the University of Minnesota. You can learn more about him in a display case on the east side of our building. Let us pray that we can all respond to the Lord with generous hearts the way Bruce Smith did.
