**World Day
of the Poor**

The World Day of the Poor is a Roman Catholic observance, celebrated on the 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time. It was established in 2017 by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter, *Misericordia et Misera*.

The World Day of the Poor was first observed with the theme, “Let us love, not with words but with deeds.” In his message for that first World Day of the Poor, Pope Francis said that “the *Our Father* is the prayer of the poor.” He held a special Mass in St. Peter’s Basilica, followed by a free lunch in the adjacent Paul VI Hall, in several Catholic colleges, and in other Vatican venues. During the week preceding the World Day of the Poor, free specialized medical services were offered at a mobile clinic.

The day was also observed in other countries, including India, Poland, and Canada, with special Masses, free meals for the poor, and other initiatives.

In our daily prayer, let us ask for the grace and the strength to carry out our resolves to practice charity towards our neighbors, especially the poor and the sick.
