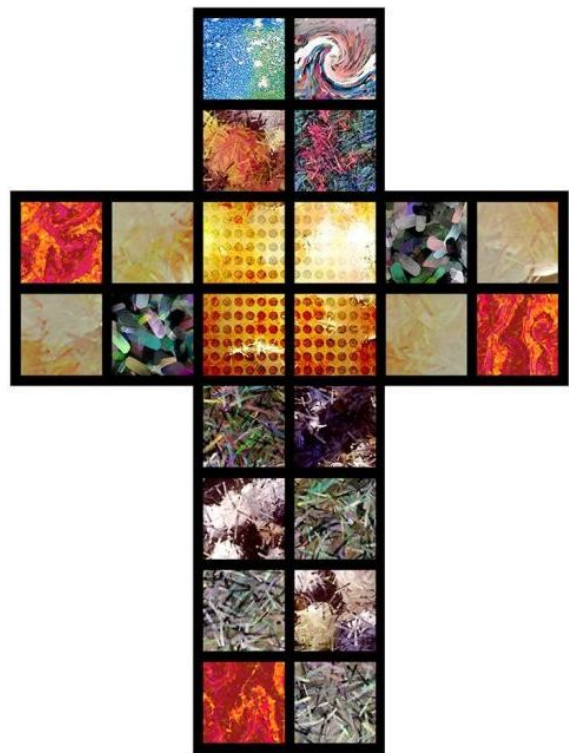

Dear Parishioners and Students of St Lawrence Newman Center:

Archbishop Hebda has announced, with great sorrow, that the celebration of public Masses in the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis is suspended, effective immediately. I know this decision was very difficult for him, but he made it out of a genuine concern for you, the People of God, in the light of the Coronavirus epidemic. The best way to end the epidemic is social distancing regardless if you have the virus or not. If you don't catch it, you cannot spread it. We are implementing the following changes to support that directive, effective immediately. These are subject to change as the situation changes.

Please go to our website [www.umncatholic.org](http://www.umncatholic.org) for links to online Masses.

Masses may be offered for funerals or weddings, but the guidelines call for no more than ten people present at such Masses. For funerals, there will be no visitation at the church beforehand and no lunches in the church building afterward.

St Lawrence will be open for prayer from 10 am to 2 pm Monday - Friday with confession available at 12:45 pm. Saturday, the church will be open at 9:30 am to 10:30 am for confessions. We ask that you maintain a distance of 6 ft distance between you and others. The church will be closed on Sunday. The parish office will be closed until Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

All parish programs are canceled until further notice. Where possible. We will implement the use of video conferencing for small groups. We will be posting video reflections twice each day beginning Monday, March 23. Please look for them on our website at [www.umncatholic.org](http://www.umncatholic.org)

These changes will be in effect for at least two weeks and possibly considerably longer, depending on the course of the Coronavirus pandemic, direction from the Archbishop and advice from civil authorities and experts.
