Fr. Colvard

Father Francis T. Colvard, C.S.Sp. died June 15 at St. Clair Memorial Hospital in Mount Lebanon.

Born in Philadelphia in 1919, Fr. Colvard entered the Holy Ghost Fathers' Junior Seminary at Cornwells Heights, Pa., in 1933 and was professed in 1940.

Ordained at Norwalk, Connecticut in 1945, he was assigned to the Holy Ghost Fathers' parish in Lake Charles, La. During the course of his ministry, Fr. Colvard served in Wisconsin, California, Michigan and Pennsylvania. His last assignment was at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church in Polish Hill. When illness forced him to retire in 1979, he took up residence at Immaculate Heart Seminary in Bethel Park.

A Mass of Christian burial was celebrated at Bethel on Friday, June 18.

Burial was at the Holy Ghost Fathers' Seminary at Cornwells Heights in Bensalem, Pa.

Fr. Colvard is survived by his mother, Mrs. George Colvard, a

resident of the Wall Home on Benton Avenue, Pittsburgh.

A Mass of Christian burial was celebrated at Bethel on Friday, June 18. Father William Headley, C.S.Sp., provincial, was the principal celebrant and Father John Murray, C.S.Sp. of St. Ann's, Millvale, was the homilist.
