

Brother Francis W. Sullivan, C.S.Sp.

Brother Francis died Tuesday, March 10<sup>th</sup> at Mount Meru Regional Hospital in Arusha at the age of 90 after being diagnosed with malaria and pneumonia. He was born July 15, 1918 and professed his vows January 16, 1950 at Holy Ghost Novitiate, Ridgefield CT.

He was appointed to Ferndale (1950-1953) and then was assigned to the Kilimanjaro District in Africa. His first major assignment was in the Diocese of Moshi where he built a church with a seating capacity of 1,800 at Kibosho. In the course of his 50 years in Tanzania we find him working at Monduli, Endulen, Loliondo, Ngorongoro and various other locations where he built several churches, rectories, two seminaries, hospitals, a bridge and many other facilities. He will always be remembered for his great interest in building and hunger relief action for the Maasai Community.

Mass of Resurrection will take place Wednesday, March 18<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 am in the Usa River Seminary Chapel with burial in the Spiritan Cemetery there.
