



Bakery at Chonku



For many years inhabitants of north east Nigeria have lived in fear of a group described by the BBC as follows: *Nigeria's militant Islamist group Boko Haram – which has caused*

havoc in Africa's most populous country through a wave of bombings, assassinations and abductions – is fighting to overthrow the government and create an Islamic state.

Against that backdrop Spiritans are in the lead in bringing the Gospel to a large population which has not yet heard the message of Christ—a challenging task with Christians comprising less than 10% of all Nigerians. In Chonku, Taraba State, Nigeria.

Fr. Kuha Indyer, CSSp. is living the congregation's vision of creating a youth center and bakery to provide employable skills that will allow area youth to earn a living in an economically depressed region of the country. The bakery would serve the local community with profits going to support the operation and maintain its functionality.

The cost of the bakery project is \$12,720, and will employ 10 people once fully operational.

The youth center construction is underway as indicated by the adjacent photo.
