For your information:

- **Lateness to school** – Being on time sets the tone for the day. It also impacts the grade on the personal growth section on the report card. If a student has more than three latenesses in a year, he/she will not be eligible for perfect attendance award.
- **Absence from school** - Regular attendance is a necessity for successful learning. When a student is absent, he/she is expected to make up all work missed. It is the responsibility of each student to have a “study buddy”. The study partner will be asked to record class work and assignments along with gathering books which will be placed in the lobby at 2:20 PM. Should a student have any difficulties with this procedure, his/her parents should email the homeroom teacher for assistance. All communication should be forwarded through email to the homeroom teacher and not the school office.
 - *Please notify the nurse’s office for any absence AND send in a letter of explanation to the homeroom teacher on the day the child returns to school.*
- **Absence from school for vacation** – This is recorded as an illegal absence. All missing work and missed tests must be completed the day the student returns to school.
- **Returning back to school for forgotten items** – Only the child will be admitted to his or her classroom after signing the log at the front desk. Access to the school building is limited to 2:30-3:30 M-Th; before 2:45 on Friday and before holidays; and before 12:30 on 11:30 dismissal days.
- **Dropping lunch off and bringing special lunches to school** – We are unable to deliver lunch of any kind; students will share with those who forgot their lunch; Special lunches are strictly forbidden.
- **Ordering of pizza and hot lunches** – These are pre-ordered one month in advance. Orders that arrive after 8:45 AM will not be accepted.— this is strictly enforced
- **Discipline Code**—please read the back pages of the calendar to become aware of school policies and uniform requirements.

- **Birthday Celebrations** –Grades 4-8 are not permitted to provide birthday treats. Students are invited to wear to school “***dress up clothes***” on their birthday. For the boys, dress slacks, a shirt with a collar and shoes must be worn. For the girls, dress slacks, shoes (no flip flops) dresses and skirts that do not exceed one inch below the knee must be worn. **Please no jeans or sneakers.**
- **Bus Transportation** -- There is no transfer of bus privileges to any other bus. A student can only go home on the bus he/she is assigned. If a bus student will be a walker on a particular day, he/she must bring a note to school signed by the parent stating that fact.
- **Web Site**—The school web site is a great resource for keeping up with the life of the school and the happenings in each classroom. Please take advantage of this opportunity by visiting the site frequently and fully.
