Welcome to St. Brigid/Our Lady of Hope Regional School Full Day Kindergarten Program!

The first day of school will be **Wednesday, September 4th. We will have 11:30 am dismissal.** We will also have **11:30 am dismissal on Thursday, September 5th.** Friday will be the first full day of school. Dismissal will be at 3:00 pm.

On Wednesday, September 4th, please bring your child to Our Lady's Chapel, if you will be driving your child to school. If your child will be riding the bus, he or she will be directed to the Chapel upon arrival. Arrival time will be between 8:30 am and 8:50 am.

Please find the enclosed supply list for Kindergarten. All supplies should be sent to school on the designated dates. Since some of the children are riding the bus, it makes it easier to send in the supplies a little at a time. We do ask, however, that you send a backpack to school **everyday**, beginning on the first day of school.

Please send in a morning snack and drink for your child each day. We ask that you send in a healthy snack (crackers, goldfish, pretzels, fruit, etc.). Please do not send in candy.

Please supply a nametag that your child will need to wear for the first week of school. Using a permanent marker, please write your child's name, the name of your school district and bus number at the bottom of the tag. **This is extremely important, as it will allow us to verify the correct bus your child is on!** If you will be picking your child up from school daily, simply write "car rider" at the bottom. Please meet him/her in the chapel at 3:00 pm. There will be parking available in the side parking lot, located off St. Brigid Lane. Please notify us, in writing, if there are any changes or if someone different will be picking up your child from school that day. **Thank you for your cooperation in this very important matter!**

Friday, September 6th will be our first full day of school. You will receive information for ordering lunch online before school begins in September. Please be sure to have ordered lunch online by midnight, the day before, or pack a lunch box or bag, clearly labeled with your child's name.

We are looking forward to an exciting and rewarding school year. Enjoy the remainder of the summer!
