

Compound Sentences

A compound sentence has two subjects and two predicates combined with a coordinating conjunction and a comma.

Each subject and predicate can stand on its own as a sentence (independent clause).

Subject Predicate , FANBOYS Subject Predicate

I would like chicken for dinner , but my mother is making turkey.

For- similar to because

And- adding more

Nor- opposite, neither

But- disagrees/debates

Or- choices

Yet- similar to 'but'

So- gives a reason
