<p>Spelling Story Write your spelling words in a story!</p>	<p>Spelling Syllabication Write each of your spelling words and draw lines to show where the word breaks into syllables.</p>	<p>Round Up the Rhymes Write each of your words and write a rhyming word with the same spelling pattern. If there's no real word that rhymes you can make up a word with the same pattern.</p>	<p>Rainbow Words Write the words using a different color for each letter!</p>	<p>ABC Order Write your words in alphabetical order.</p>
<p>Type-It Type your spelling words and print or email them to your teacher.</p>	<p>All About Alliteration Make an alliterative phrase for each of your words. Example: <i>seven sticky stamps</i></p>	<p>Spelling Bee Have a parent, sibling, or friend call out your spelling words to you while you spell them out loud.</p>	<p>Consonants & Vowels Write your spelling words. Circle the vowels and underline the consonants.</p>	<p>Spelling Mural Draw a picture and hide your spelling words in it.</p>
<p>Pyramid Write your words in a pyramid shape. <i>r</i> <i>ri</i> <i>rid</i> <i>ride</i></p>	<p>Handwriting Write your spelling words 3 times: once in your best handwriting, once as small as you can, and once in a curly style.</p>	<p>Practice Test Take a practice spelling test with an adult family member.</p>	<p>Index Cards Make flashcards with all of your spelling words and then study with someone at home</p>	<p>Backwards Words Write your words forwards and then backwards <i>wind</i> <i>dniw</i></p>

Monday: Write the words three times each.
