The requirements for the Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion ministry are: you must be at least 18 years of age; Confirmed; a practicing Catholic able to receive Holy Communion; and if married, you must be validly married in a Catholic Church.

Current EMHCs are also invited to attend any part of this training program as a refresher, especially those of you who have not attended refresher training in the last couple of years.
