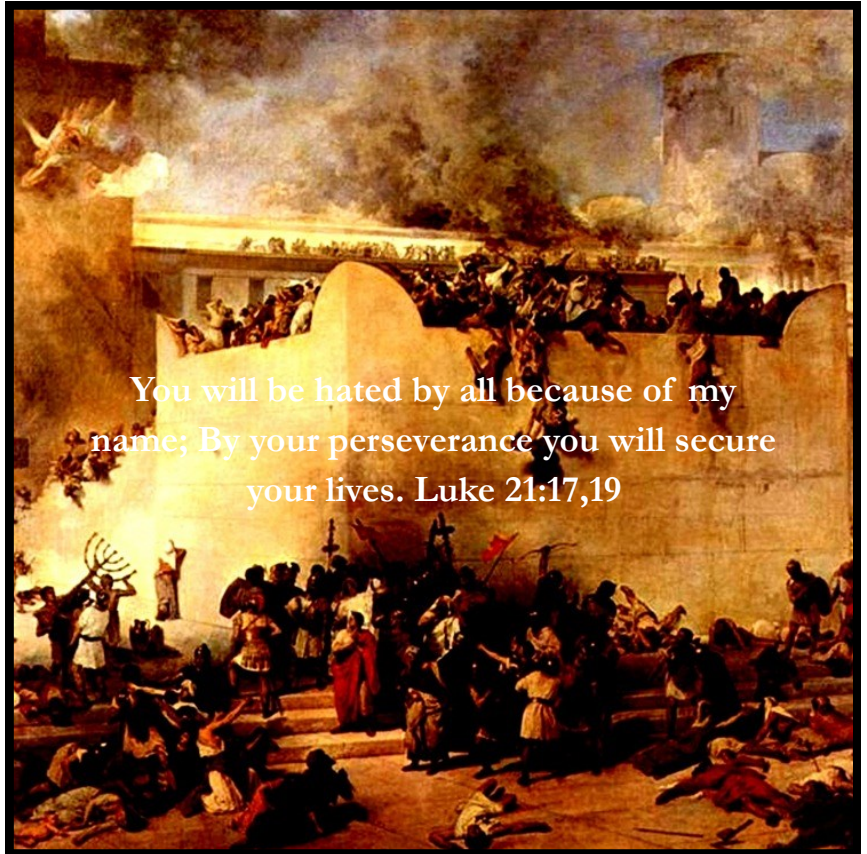

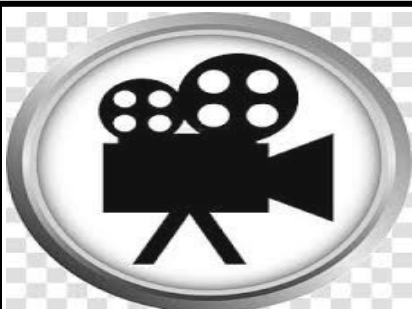

Novena in Honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe

To be recited from the 3rd to the 11th of December

This is a beautiful nine day devotion to the Blessed Mother with the celebration ending with her Feast Day on December 12th.

Our Lady of Guadalupe is especially celebrated within the Spanish community because she appeared to Juan Diego at Tepeyac Hill near Mexico City. Many extraordinary events took place there. On the 12th of October, 1945, Pope Pius XII proclaimed Our Lady of Guadalupe the Patroness of all the Americas. She is widely invoked as the “protector of the unborn”. Her Feast Day is a Holy Day of obligation in Mexico.

Let us pray this Novena together with our Spanish community every evening during these nine days of prayer and petition to Our Lady. Dates and times will be posted in the upcoming bulletin.
