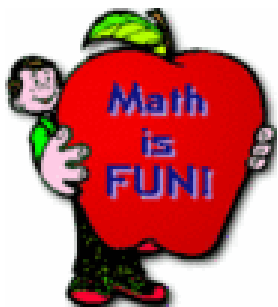

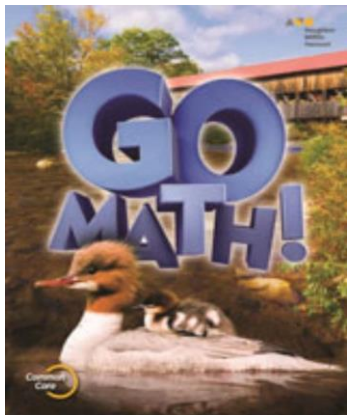

*Use capitalization rules.

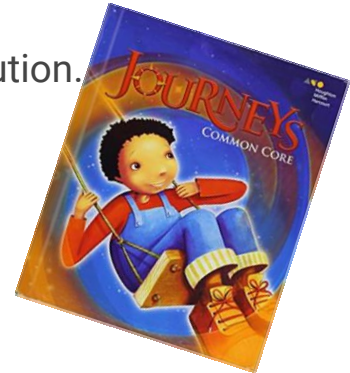
*Write a story with a beginning, middle, and end.

Reading:

*The program includes weekly spelling lessons, phonics, daily language practice, grammar instruction, and a written expression component.

Reading instruction is done with the whole class, and also in small groups. The students will take benchmark assessments to evaluate their progress.

The students will be able to:

*Read with understanding.

*Decode unfamiliar words.

*Know long and short vowel sounds, consonant clusters and digraphs, and vowel combinations.

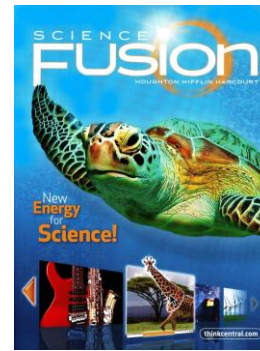
*Recognize and use story vocabulary and high frequency words.

*Identify story parts (beginning, middle, end)

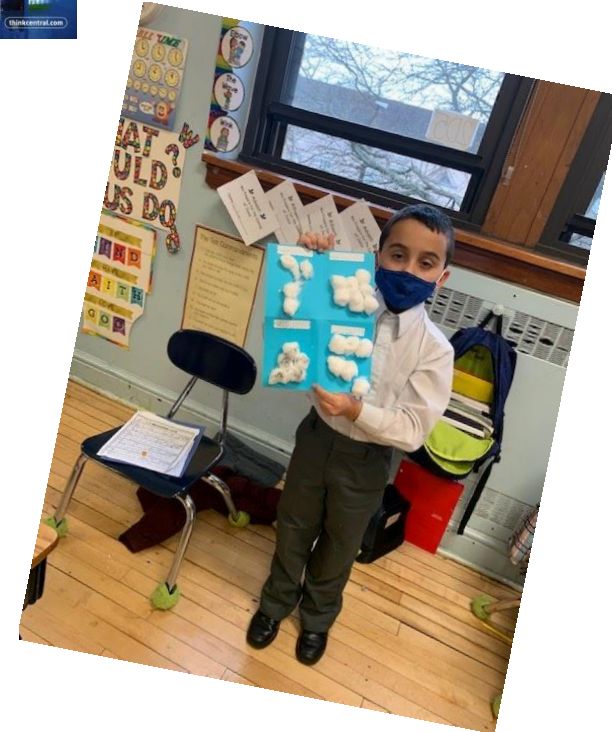

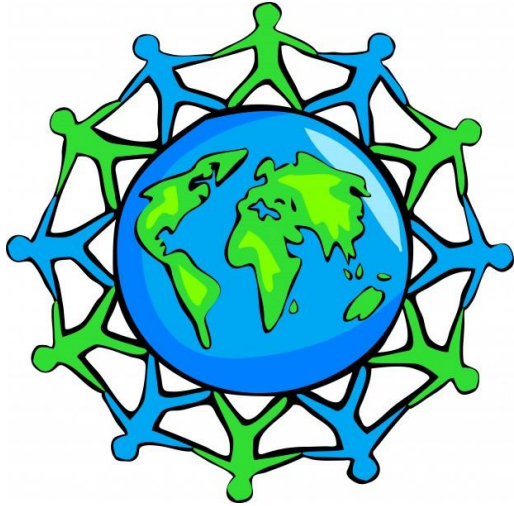

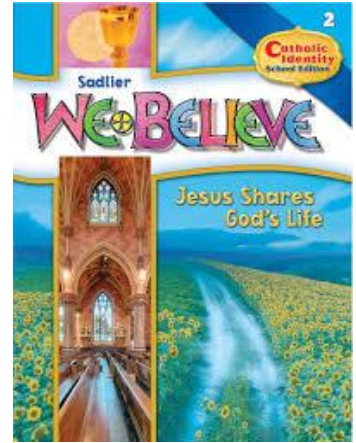

HOMework

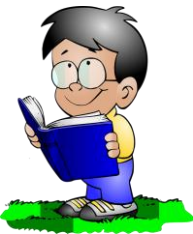


- **Monday - Thursday**
- **Spelling Tic Tac Toe** - Students will choose three spelling activities each week and complete them in their spelling notebook. On Thursday, students will complete the independent reading pages in the Reader's Notebook and study for their spelling test.
- **Math** - workbook pages to reinforce the day's lesson
- **Daily Reading** - Students should be reading every night for approximately 15-20 minutes. Please enter reading in their reading log and answer related questions. Hand in on Fridays.



ASSESSMENTS

1. **Spelling** - Every Friday the students will have a spelling test on the sixteen words we have been working on throughout the week.
2. **Reading Comprehension** - Every Friday the children will take a reading comprehension test on the story of the week. Students will be able to use their books to help them answer the questions.
3. **Math** - Math tests will be given approximately once a month depending on the length and difficulty of the chapter. Students will receive a study guide to help prepare for the test.
