Please review our mask policy to make sure that we have success with the safe use of masks in our building:

- All students, faculty, staff, and visitors will be required to wear a CDC-approved face-covering whenever they are moving about the building or in the classroom.
- Neck gaiters, open chin triangle bandanas, and costume masks are not allowed.



- Student face coverings must be of a solid color and may not include any logos besides the St. Anne's School logo.
- Mask breaks will be scheduled during the day.
- Students will have a 6-foot distance during lunch so they can remove masks.
- All adults who enter the building must supply and wear a cloth mask or face covering that covers their nose and mouth.
- Students are asked to supply their own mask or face covering. We will maintain a supply of extra masks for students.

Your participation in PickUp Patrol has made our arrival, dismissal, and health questionnaire process move smoothly. If you have not done so, we ask that you please start to use PickUp Patrol to help Saint Anne's School navigate these procedures.
