Dear Parent/Guardian:

I hope this note finds you and your family safe and well. I wanted to share with you the grade specific Health requirements that are routinely set out by New York State each year in regard to incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders

- All students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade must receive the first dose of the Meningococcal Conjugate vaccine (MCV4 or MenACWY) before the first day of school. (Minimum age to have received the vaccine is 10 years old)
- New York State Education Law requires that all Students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade must have a Physical Examination within the last 12 months. (any exam dated on or after 9/8/20 will fulfill this requirement)
- Please note that the **Updated New York State Health Certificate** is the only form that will be accepted as a valid Physical exam form for the new year. Please check with your health care provider to schedule an appointment as soon as possible to make sure your child has the needed immunizations for school entry in September.

It is also recommended that your child have a dental examination. The New York State Physical Exam Form and Dental form can be found on the school website under--- **School Resources/Nurse and Health info/health form.**

These are New York State mandated requirements for school attendance. Our goal is to provide and promote a healthy school environment for our students. Well checkups and up to dates vaccinations are the foundation of good health.
