

2020-2021 First Grade Supply List

Dear Families,

We will be taking extra precautions to limit the spread of germs. Therefore, students will need to have their own supplies and will not be permitted to share. Supply boxes will travel to and from school on a daily basis. Please check to ensure that pencils are routinely sharpened and be prepared to replenish supplies as needed. Thank you!

Classroom/Art Supplies

- 4 sharpened #2 pencils (Please sharpen each night)
- 1 large pink eraser (not the pencil toppers)
- 1 highlighter (any color)
- 1 colored pen - Used for self-correcting/editing classwork (Not Black or Blue)
- 1 black Sharpie marker
- 1 black dry erase marker (fine tip)
- 1 dry erase board eraser (an old sock will do)
- 1 box Crayola Crayons (no more than 24)
- 1 pack of Crayola markers
- 1 pair of child scissors (Fiskars and Westcott work best)
- 2 glue sticks

Put all of the above supplies in a supply box or pouch labeled with your child's name.

Please label the following with your child's name:

- 1 Backpack (No wheels)
- 3 heavy-duty folders with horizontal pockets along bottom
(Label 1: Home Folder, Label 2: Classwork Folder, Label 3: Writing Folder)
- 2 wide ruled composition books (Label 1: Word Work, Label 2: Journal)
- 1 spiral-bound art sketchbook (approximately 9x12)
- 1 set of headphones - Put in a Ziplock bag with your child's name
- 1 lunchbox
- 1 reusable water bottle
- 1 paper towel roll *Do not label

Please also send in \$10 in an envelope labeled with your child's name and "Scholastic Weekly Magazines."

Please make a personal care pouch for your child, which may include items such as pocket tissues, personal hand sanitizer, extra mask, chapstick, thin pack of wipes, and any other personal care items your child may need throughout the day. Students will keep the pouch in their desk for the day and use as necessary to minimize classroom movement and maintain social distancing. Your child will take the pouch home each night. *Please replenish as needed.

Any hard cover books should be covered and labeled with your child's name. They may be covered with book socks, paper, or clear contact covers. **Keep all textbooks and workbooks at home for the time being. You will be notified when to bring in as needed.**
